







Schedule for Camellias

(All flowers must have one leaf attached)

Class	Description	
1. Single	One row of not over eight regular, irregular or loose petals and conspicuous stamens.	
2. Semi Double	Two or more rows of regular, irregular or loose petals and conspicuous stamens.	
3. Anemone	One or more rows of large petals lying flat or undulating with a central mass of petaloids and stamens.	
and Peony	A deep rounded flower of intermingled petals and petaloids, either with or without stamens.	
4. Rose Form Double	Overlapping petals showing stamens in a concave centre when fully opened.	
5. Formal Double	Many overlapping rows of petals. Never showing stamens.	
6. Variegated and Striped	Lines or streaks of petal colour.	
7. Miniature	6.5cm or less in diameter
