2018 Rose Show

Definitions

Stem:	Branches coming from a five-leaf joint should be removed from a stem
Fully Open Bloom:	Past three quarters open
Exhibition Bloom:	Half to three quarters open
Decorative Bloom:	One quarter to one half open
Bud:	Sepals separated, colour showing and not more than two petals unfurled

Schedule

Class A:

- A1** One exhibition bloom
- A2** One decorative bloom
- A3** Three roses of one or more varieties in one vase, three stems
 - 1 bud
 - 1 exhibition bloom
 - 1 fully open bloom
- A4** One stem of roses with 4 or more flowers open
- A5** One stem of roses, not more than 3 flowers open
- A6** One fully open bloom
- A7** Three blooms, one or more varieties in one vase
- A8** Three stems, one or more varieties in one vase
- A9** Floribunda

Class B Miniature or Patio Roses:

- B1** Three miniature or patio roses of one or more varieties in one vase, three stems
 - 1 bud
 - 1 exhibition bloom
 - 1 fully open bloom
- B2** One stem of miniature or patio roses with 4 or more flowers open
- B3** One stem of miniature or patio roses, not more than 3 flowers open

Class C Old-Fashioned Roses:

- C1** One stem
- C2** Climbers & Ramblers

Class D David Austin (English) Roses:

- D1** One stem

Class E Floral Arrangement:

- E1** A floral arrangement that showcases roses. (Competitors to supply their own containers.)

Trophies:

Evans Bowl for Class A winner
HS Hislop Trophy for Class B (Miniature or Patio Roses) winner
Walker Hall Challenge Cup for Champion Rose winner
